This is a workbook exercise page, not a teaching chapter. It asks the student to put key events from Chapter Three in order (persecutions, Constantine, the Council of Nicaea, Arius and Athanasius) and then answer review questions about the Nicene Creed, the desert monastics, and the Cappadocian communities.

Key takeaways

- It's a review activity: sequence the events, then answer questions in your own words.
- The questions circle back to the big Chapter Three ideas — 'one essence with the Father,' why Christians fled to the desert, and what made Macrina and Basil's communities different.
- No new content to learn here; use it to check what you remember from the chapter.
